DEACONS UPDATE

The deacons met on September 6 for the first meeting of the 2022-2023 church year.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Jennie Jones. Pastor Jason presented the devotion. He welcomed the new members and thanked the returning members for their continuing service. Pastor Jason explained this committee is much more that a group overseeing the business of the church. We are here to serve through our leadership, support of church services and functions and offering support to our fellow church members. We are to strive to live daily in a way that reflects Jesus' teachings and love. Although there will be discouraging times, we are to remain steadfast, pick up our "towel" and continue to serve.

The newly elected officers are:

Charles Livengood, Chair; Jennie Jones, Vice Chair and Dianne Davis, Secretary. Members received Deacon of the Week list, Deacon Family list and a copy of the church constitution. Future meetings will be the first Tuesday of each month at 6:30 pm.

Insurance update: On August 8, the Finance Committee met with Glenn Jones, insurance representative. They were told the treasurer, assistant treasurers and anyone who deals with money are bonded for \$25,000 per incident under our existing policy. An Employment Practice Liability policy added to the existing policy for an additional \$114.00 will provide coverage up to one

million dollars for 1st party (employed) and 3rd party (volunteer) staff. The Finance Committee felt this should be a deacon decision. A motion was made and seconded and all agreed to accept this proposal and to present the paperwork to the Trustees for necessary signatures. The Finance Committee will be informed.

Roy Lasher and Pastor Jason are continuing to work on a plan to insure our safety while on church property. The project to tint the windows in the sanctuary and educational buildings has been completed.

Impact 2022 continues to serve the community. Additional Food Lion gift cards have been purchased as well as another 4 backpacks. Food and housing is an increasing concern and we should continue to remember these needs in our prayers. The pumpkins will be arriving October 1. There is no cost to the church for the pumpkins and we will receive 25% of the sales.

The playground is temporarily closed due to concerns about some of the equipment.

Pastor Jason closed the meeting with prayer.
